Tips from the Pros - Saarloos Vineyards - April 18

Those of you that were at our member meeting at Avila know that we will be expanding our Grape Coop options this year by adding 5 Varietals from Saarloos Vineyards. We will now have the opportunity to purchase and make wine from Grenache Blanc, Grenache Noir, Sauvignon Blanc (Jerry Shoemakers Best of Show Wine), Cabernet Sauvignon (unavailable from L&L last year), and Syrah from Ballard Canyon AVA (the one I'm most excited about). To give you a chance to taste each of these wines as well as tour the vineyard where they are produced, we have been able to set up a very special event this month.

On **April 20**th from 12:30-2PM we will be meeting with Larry Saarloos who will give us a tour of their Windmill Ranch vineyard which is at the corner of Highway 101 and Highway 154. I don't have the exact address but as you get off the 101, you can't miss it because it is under the Windmill ③. Larry will be talking about the farming practices that allows his son to make their award winning wine which we will be sampling as we walk the vineyard. If you are at all interested in working with these grapes this year, this is an opportunity NOT TO BE MISSED.
